Please note that if you wish to utilize certifying authorities not included in the approved list, suppliers are required to submit all relevant documentation for review and approval. This documentation must be submitted to the Inspection Team at least one month in advance

Required documentation for review:

- CV of surveyor: Demonstrating qualifications and experience related to lifting equipment and crane inspection
- Copy of certificates:
 - Lifting Equipment Inspection (certified Body/LEEA/API RP 2D)
 - Welding inspection and be certified by CSWIP or CWI or appropriated training program
 - NDE and be certified by ASNT or PCN or appropriated training course
 - Painting inspection and be certified by BGAS/CSWIP or NACE or appropriated training program

- Validation of CSWIP 3.1 / CWI certificates is more preferable
- Validation of ASNT / PCN NDT Level 2 certificates is more preferable
